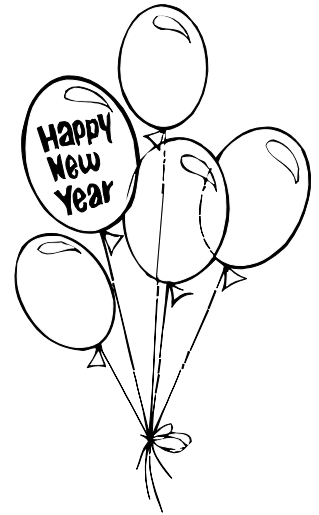

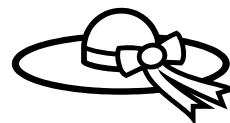

Due to insurance requirements, it is necessary for us to register all dogs in the park. Please provide a copy of your dog's shot records plus the following information

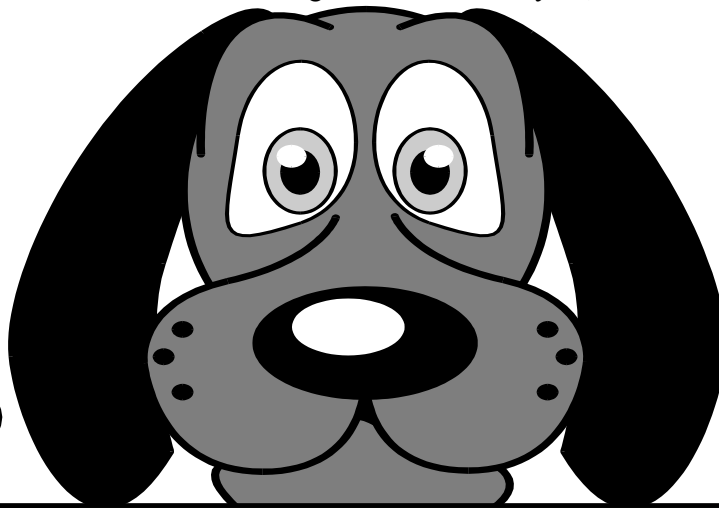
